

THE VETENARY PROTOCOL 2024 FENCES SELECTION AUCTION - DEAUVILLE

This vet check will be the reference test for the formal warranty granted to the buyers.

1) X-ray examination:

The x-ray test (375 € HT excl VAT, done by the Fences Auction Veterinarian) must include the 20 following rays. Shoes off. (Left and right side):

- Front view of the front feet (on the oblique hold),
- Lateral view of the front feet (on the flat hold),
- Front view of the front fetlocks,
- Lateral view of the front fetlocks,

- Front view of the hind fetlocks.
- Lateral view of the hind fetlocks,
- Front and lateral view of the hocks,
- Front and lateral view of the stifles.

Horses who had previous X-rays can skip this examination if those had been taken 6 months before the auction. They arefully transmitted to the Fences veterinarian referent by email at contact@fences.fr in jpeg and of perfect quality. To be accepted, X-rays must contain those following information:

- Horse's identification,
- Date,

- Your vet's name,
 - X-rays's identification.

An osteo articular report, based on those rays, will be emitted by the Fences vet. Any information given before the report cannotbe consider as a confirmation. According to this report, the Fences vet will decide to accept or refuse the horse for the auction.

2) Clinical examination:

The seller must, in the week preceding the date of the auction and at the latest 72 hours before this date, transmit to the FENCES Agency, a good health certificate. In case of doubt on the arrival of the horse at the place of sale, the Fences Agency reserves the right to carry out a veterinary check-up. This exam includes:

A - Functional examination:

- Pulmonary and cardiac examination by auscultation,
- Cardiac rhythm at rest and after effort,
- Eyes examination (cornea, retina and crystalline),
- Examination of stance and postural anomalies,
- Presence of recent injuries or wounds.
- Buccal examination

B - Dynamics exams:

Locomotion on the 3 paces:

- Walk on a straight line and on a 8 figure (hard ground),
- Trot on line (hard ground), on a circle (hard and soft ground),
- Canter on a circle (soft ground).

3) Blood tests:

Agence Fences will provide you with a LABEO form allowing you to benefit from preferential rates for the analysis of your horses present at one of our auctions.

a. Coggins test

This test is compulsory for all horses admitted to the auction ring. It must be less than one month old before the auction.

b. Piroplasmosis test

This test is recommended by the Fences Agency. In fact, if the buyer requires a piroplasmosis test to be able to import the horse into its country of destination and the test proves positive, the sale will be cancelled under the guarantee. To avoid this obligation, the Seller will have the possibility of having a piroplasmosis test carried out at his own expense within 15 days prior to the auction by a laboratory approved by Agence FENCES. The result of this test will appear in the veterinary file of each horse.

The seller agrees that his horses be sold with the warranties granted by Fences Agency. They give a mandate to the FENCES Agency to carry out the mediation provided by the FENCES warranties in the terms and conditions of sale in particular as regards the veterinarian examination and treatment that may be provided. Following the mediation, in case of flaw or defect affecting the substantive quality of the horse intended for a sporting career, hidden or unknow prior to the sale the purchaser shall be reimbursed by FENCES Agency. In this event, the seller agrees to take back the horse at his expense and to reimburse the Fences Agency for the amount received from the auction. They shall receive a fixed rate compensation the amount of which is fixed on the warranty certificate.
