

Fences Elite Auction Vet-check procedure 2024

This vet-check will be the reference test for the formal warranty granted to the buyer. The 2 years old and more horses will be vet tested including a set of x-ray pictures (€ 375 ex VAT) and a clinical test (€ 108,33. ex VAT) these tests are at seller's expense, to be paid directly to the veterinarian.

1. Radiography Exam:

The x-ray test (375 € HT excl VAT, done by the Fences Auction Veterinarian) must include the 20 following rays: Shoes off. (left and right side):

- Front view of the front feet (on the oblique hold),
- Lateral view of the front feet (on the flat hold),
- Front view of the front fetlocks,
- Lateral view of the front fetlocks,
- Front view of the hind fetlocks,
- Lateral view of the hind fetlocks,
- Front and lateral view of the hocks,
- Front and lateral view of the stifles.

An osteo articular report, based on those X-rays, will be emitted by the Fences vet. Any information given before the report cannot be consider as a confirmation. According to this report, the Fences vet will decide to accept or refusethe horse for the auction.

Horses who had previous X-rays can skip this examination if those had been taken after the 1st of March 2024 and if the X-rays have been presented to the auction vet this day. They have to be fully transmitted to the Fences veterinarian referent by email at contact@fences.fr in jpeg and of perfect quality. To be accepted, X-rays must contain that following information:

- Horse's identification,

The vet's name,

- Date,

X-rays's identification.

2. Clinical Exam:

A first clinical examination will take place on the selection day, in order to disqualify the horse showing a visible defects of heart, lungs, eyes, etc...

A clinical test will be done on each horse upon arrival at the auction's place. (Cost € 108,33 excl VAT). According to this test, the Fences vet will definitely decide to accept or refuse to include a horse in the auction's collection.

This clinical test aims to remove horses who have not tolerated the training or who do not provide all thewarranties of good health.

3. Blood tests:

Agence Fences will provide you with a LABEO form allowing you to benefit from preferential rates for the analysis of your horses present at one of our auctions.

a. Coggins test

This test is compulsory for all horses admitted to the auction ring. It must be less than one month old before the auction.

b. Piroplasmosis test

This test is recommended by the Fences Agency. In fact, if the buyer requires a piroplasmosis test to be able to import the horse into its country of destination and the test proves positive, the sale will be cancelled under the guarantee. To avoid this obligation, the Seller will have the possibility of having a piroplasmosis test carried out at his own expense within 15 days prior to the auction by a laboratory approved by Agence FENCES. The result of this test will appear in the veterinary file of each horse.

The seller agrees to sell his horse with warranty granted by Fences Agency. He gives mandate to Fences Agency to lead the mediation provided by the warranty as stated at the general conditions in particular regarding the vet checks and treatments to be performed on the horse. At the mediation end, in case of default affecting the horse capacity to havea sport career, not found or known before the auction Fences will reimburse the buyers of the auction's amount. In this case the seller agrees to take his horse back at his own expenses. Fences Agency will grant the buyer a flat rate indemnity as stated on the warranty agreement.
