



VET-CHECK PROCEDURE – PERFORMERS AUCTIONS 2024

HORSE'S NAME:

A formal guarantee is issued to buyers. Selected horses aged of 4 and over will undergo a veterinary check consisting of:

A. X-RAYS exam (450 € HT / 540 € TTC) is at the seller's expense and have to be paid directly to the FENCES veterinarian.

Radiography exam is carried during the selection at the seller's expense and paid directly to the vet.

It includes 23 images - Horseshoes removed:

- Front / Lateral view of the front feet (on the oblique hold)
- Front / Lateral view of the front fetlocks
- Front / Lateral view of the hind fetlocks
- Front / Lateral view of the hocks,
- Front / Lateral view of the stifles
- X-rays of thoracic and lumbar apophyses (3 x-rays)

An osteo articular report, based on those X-rays, will be emitted by the Fences vet. Any information given before the report cannot be consider as a confirmation. According to this report, the Fences vet will decide to accept or refuse the horse for the auction.

Good-quality X-rays taken less than 6 months before the auction could be accepted. The Fences veterinarian will decide if they are of acceptable quality or if they need to be redone. Reading and validation of your own x-rays by the FENCES veterinarian will be charge of €50 (excl. VAT) to be paid by the seller, directly to the Fences veterinarian.

Images of sufficient technical quality, identified in the image **with the name of the horse and the veterinarian, sent by e-mail in JPG format to contact@fences.fr will be accepted.** No CDs will be accepted.

X-rays must contain that following information:

- Horse's identification,
- Date,
- The vet's name,
- X-rays's identification.

B. Clinical Exam

A first clinical examination will take place on the selection day, to disqualify the horse showing a visible defect of heart, lungs, eyes, etc...

A clinical test will be done on each horse upon arrival at the auction's place and will determine the final access or not to the auction, it is at the seller's expense and to be paid directly to the veterinarian (108,33 € HT / 130€ TTC).

This clinical test aims to remove horses who have not tolerated the training or who do not provide all the warranties of good health.

C. Blood tests – Coggins & Piroplasmosis

The Seller is informed that Coggins and Piroplasmosis tests are mandatory for performers. He will have the opportunity to make this test at his own expense within 15 days prior to the auction by a laboratory approved by Fences Agency. If the seller has not carried out the test prior to the auction, if the test is positive, the sale will be cancelled, in accordance with the Fences warranty. If the Seller has realised this test prior to the auction, the risk of piroplasmosis is covered and removed from the warranty. The result of the test will be public and added to vet check protocol.

Agence Fences will provide you with a LABEO form allowing you to benefit from preferential rates for the analysis of your horses present at one of our auctions.

The seller agrees to sell his horse with warranty granted by Fences Agency. He gives mandate to Fences Agency to lead the mediation provided by the warranty as stated at the general conditions in particular regarding the vet checks and treatments to be performed on the horse. At the mediation end, in case of default affecting the horse capacity to have a sport career, not found or known before the auction Fences will reimburse the buyers of the auction's amount. In this case the seller agrees to take his horse back at his own expenses. Fences Agency will grant the buyer a flat rate indemnity as stated on the warranty agreement.
